

Where can I buy tickets?

All ticketing is being handled by the venue. Visit the Infinite Energy website and click on the Events tab. Click on the Southern Outdoor Show and choose your ticket options.

What are the prices?

The Seminar and Expo is \$89. The Expo is only \$15. Two day Expo tickets are \$23.

As with all online ticket purchases, the venue has additional service fee charges added to the ticket price. We cannot control or negotiate these. Parking is \$5 at the venue and you can add that option to your ticket or pay at the parking garage.

Is there food?

Yes! All food will be sold through the on-site concession service provided by the venue. There are also restaurants near the venue.

Beer will be available.

What are the hours?

Friday 1/15/2021 5pm-9pm. Saturday, the doors open at 8am for the Expo. The Seminar starts at 9 am and ends at 4. The Expo closes at 7pm.
